The SPA 2020 Biennial Exhibition

The Surrey Photographic Association Biennial Exhibition of 2020 will be remembered as no other. On 15 February, our three eminent selectors – Gwen Charnock FRPS APAGB MFIAP, Philip Charnock FRPS APAGB MFIAP, and Paul Keene FRPS MPAGB EFIAP/d3 MFIAP – did an outstanding job deciding upon the best images from a large submission from many SPA clubs. It was pleasing that so many club members took the opportunity to submit images for consideration for which we were very grateful. We received 1,857 entries from 203 club members who submitted 422 Monochrome Prints, 558 Colour Prints, 244 Nature Prints, 388 Open PDIs and 245 Nature PDIs. It was particularly pleasing that at a time when some salons and exhibitions are no longer showing prints that so many of our club members continue to produce what are the ultimate photographic images – high quality prints. All of the images in this catalogue demonstrate a high standard from our club members covering a wide range of genres, demonstrating skill and excellent photographic ability. I would like to congratulate everyone who had their work selected for the exhibition with particular congratulations to those who received awards and commendations. Our small team of volunteers worked extremely hard in collecting the images for the selectors' consideration, sorting the images and assisting the selectors in their duties, and then returning the prints not selected to the club members who had submitted them. We were looking forward to presenting an outstanding exhibition.

Not long after the exhibition selection was undertaken, the world conoravirus pandemic completely changed our plans, and the lives and plans of millions of people around the world. The country was placed by the government into various forms of isolation with people told to stay at home unless absolutely essential. Our usual venue for the exhibition, Guildford House Gallery, was, of course, closed, and there was no possibility of holding any sort of physical exhibition at the time when we had planned to do so over the month of April. As I write this foreword in early April, we still have no idea when the current restrictions will be eased or removed and so a considerable effort has been made by our Exhibitions and Events Chair, Ann Healey, to produce an exhibition catalogue to recognise the work of our members who had their images selected. It is our hope that we will be able to hold the exhibition, or at least part of the exhibition, at some time later in 2020 or in early 2021, not least because we all need something to look forward to in these difficult times and the images selected are definitely worthy of being seen by our club members and others. If it isn't possible to do this, we will at least have this catalogue as a reminder of the exhibition that never was. The effects of this pandemic will be felt for many years to come and it is my fervent hope at the present time that we come through the current emergency in the best way that we can.

Scoring

With the three selectors each awarding a score of between two and five, the minimum score available was six and the maximum fifteen. The task for the selectors is not only to choose the best images but also to select those that will make a balanced exhibition. The plan was for the winning prints to be displayed for the duration of the exhibition with the rest of the accepted prints being split between two hangings of 10 days each. This year, with a total entry of 1,224 prints, the acceptance rate was around 25% and a mark of 12 or higher guaranteed acceptance, as well as those prints which received a score of '5' from any of the selectors. A score of 11 in the PDIs was the required mark to achieve selection.



laughing. The picture is well composed and well printed with light carefully arranged to take you to the main subject.'






